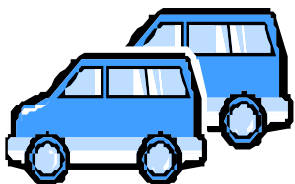


Important Information for Parents:

Safety

We hope that your child(ren) will have a really great time at Beach Mission activities, but above all we want them to be completely safe. To help achieve this, please read all the safety information on this leaflet.

Traffic: In recent years we have been increasingly concerned about the potential danger on the road outside Mallmore. Within activity times, younger children will not be allowed to cross the road alone, and older children will be closely supervised. **However, the most dangerous times are before and after activities.** We would appreciate your help to reduce the risks in the following ways:



Please do not double park, or stop on the grass verge outside Mallmore since this is where children will be crossing the road.

Young people attending activities by bike are asked not to ride on the pavement outside Mallmore. They should also try to ensure that bikes do not block the pavement or the steps up to Mallmore.



Swimming: We are not insured or legally qualified to supervise swimming in the sea. We will therefore **not** allow swimming during activities and are unable to take responsibility for children or teenagers who go in swimming at any other time.

Photos & Videos: During Beach Mission, photos and videos may be taken by children & young people, team members or other staff and volunteers of Scripture Union. Photos & videos may be used in group sessions, internally within the Mission, or in promotional literature. If you do not wish your child to be photographed or videoed, please notify us in writing.

Registration

All children and teenagers **must** be registered! Please complete a registration form and return it, if possible, before Beach Mission begins, or bring it to your first activity. Additional forms can be downloaded at www.psbmbm.org.uk

Please ensure that your child always knows who, if anyone, will collect them. The team have a very busy schedule, and while we will not leave a child unattended, we would be grateful if you would ensure that children are collected promptly.

Children who will be collected by an older brother or sister must have permission on their registration form to leave without an adult. Please do not arrange for Deckers to collect younger children in the mornings or evenings, since Decker sessions finish later than the children's groups.

For safety reasons, no child or teenager will be allowed to leave a session early unaccompanied, unless we have received a signed note from a parent or guardian.
